Teresa is a Professor of Education (Literacy) at The Open University, a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences, the Royal Society of the Arts, and the English Association. She is the UK's go-to practitioner in promoting RfP amongst our learners and a leading researcher into sustaining engagement in reading within and beyond the classroom. She has published over 30 books and leads a RfP coalition that recognises leisure reading as a tool to address social justice and leverage social change. Teresa has served as a President of the UK Reading Association and the UKLA, and on the Board Member of the BookTrust, and as a Trustee of the Poetry Archive.
